





#### Contributing to Impact Lifes positively in our Communities

Eko club of New Jersey became a chapter of ECI in the year 2000 and had since been actively participating in all functions, programs, and projects associated with our umbrella organization-Eko Club International.

As a Socio- philanthropic organization, we are manically focused to make impact in the lifes of those citizens that requires one form of help or another in our community. We are taking a major initiative to prevent accident in the school by repairing damages to the school sock-away by ensuring it is fortified to with stand the weight of daily contact by the students. Currently, the crack to the top is widening hence we have to move swiftly to fortify it.

Provision of Desks and Chairs for the Students & Teachers:

The need to provide conducive atmosphere to aid learning cannot be overemphasized, it was this imperative that made us decide to provide comfortable desks and chairs for students use. We have already identified the number of units needed by the school, and we are in the process of receiving quotes from reputable companies. At the end of this exercise, we will make our selection and we intend to commence this project by the First quarter of year 2020. It is our expectation that, this project shall be concluded by the second quarter of 2020. This project is expected to cost N2,000,000.00

Partnership with Local Organization:

We are in the process of partnering with local organization that has created a niche in providing ser-


### Eko Club Philadelphia Stuns at 2019 Eko Club International (ECI) Biennial Convention in San Antonio, Texas




